If immaturity chases 'impressive', but maturity chases love; are we raising the next generation to chase after impressive (vs 1)? How?

What happens to self love in the absence of true Christian love?

Do you love people the way that God loves you? What are some of the ways you could?

## **APPLY THE TRUTH**

What is selfless love? How is it different from the world's view of love?

Selfless love never fails; what does this look like? Is it the same as tolerance?

Since no one can mature in their faith without love, how can we pursue love intentionally?
