## Fading into Favour

### Psalm 90

*'...the Lower we go, the Higher we go...'*

## 1 REVIEW THE SERMON

LEADER NOTES: Encourage your members to pull out their notes and review the main points of the sermon. (9-12 mins)

### Reread Psalm 90

How is God both our insurance and our assurance?

How can we 'fade into God's favour' John 3:30?

What does it mean to dedicate something to God when everything we have and everything we receive is His already?

## 2 ASSESS YOUR LIFE

LEADER NOTES: Evaluate the condition of your lives in relation to the truth from God's Word. Encourage heart examination. (12-15 mins)

How has God shown His steadfast faithful love in your life?

Do you continue to put your faith in God to be delighted as He makes all things new and proves His faithfulness again and again and again?

What are some of the consequences of failing to do so ?

## 3 APPLY THE TRUTH

LEADER NOTES: Create a list of ways to close the gap between your lives and the truth of the Bible. Be practical and intentional. (12-15 mins)

How does God showing himself through temporal gifts that will pass away show His faithfulness?

How do temporal gifts prove God's favour to future generations?

How has God shown His steadfast love to our church family?

## 4 COMMIT THIS WEEK

LEADER NOTES: Call your small group members to make a commitment and get the group working together to follow-up with each other. (9-12)

We are blessed according to our faithfulness to be allowed to be stewards to the glory of God.

How will you give glory to God with that which you have been given to steward this week?
